- **Sign the petition** to rescind the Psychological Ethics and National Security (PENS) Report endorsed by the American Psychological Association (APA). The APA PENS policy supports doctor participation in interrogations, a practice that the American Medical Association, the American Psychiatric Association, and other health and human rights organizations have declared is unethical and in violation of good standards of healthcare.
